

Auction Proof of Identity Requirements

Upon registering for Auction, it is a requirement that the bidder provides photo ID issued by an Australian government authority or a financial institution showing the bidder's name and address.

An Australian Drivers Licence is an example of acceptable proof.

If the bidder does not have proof of identity which meets that requirement, they can provide two kinds of card or document, at least one of which was issued by a government authority or a financial institution and one which shows their address.

For example, a Medicare card, a birth certificate, ATM card or overseas document such as passport or driver's licence as main proof of identity AND a document showing the bidder's address, such as a utilities bill or a rental agreement.
